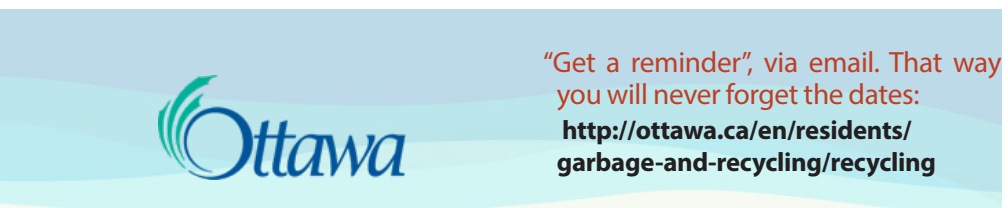
Name your "Common Room" Potluck
